Small groups are our home based continuous groups that incorporate aspects of Sunday school, bible study, fellowship and discipleship with a focus on relationship. A healthy productive Small Group allows other Christians into our lives at an intimate level. These groups are intentionally small for transparency, confidentiality and accountability.

Bible Studies focus on a specific themes, character traits or books of the bible. For example: a bible study may cover the Old Testament or a book from the Old Testament. Likewise, a bible study may cover a topic: Godly Marriage or series of Topics: Behold Your God. Last, Bible Studies may cover themes such as Heroes of the Bible or God Honoring women. Bible studies may be ongoing, one time offerings held at church or elsewhere.

These small and large groups usually gather at the church for learning, application, fellowship, discipleship ad bible study. Fellowship groups are specialty groups based around a common trait or interest with a focus of how to do "it" God's way.



Life Groups and Childcare

At Emmanuel we love children and have many great programs designed specifically for them. On Sunday mornings we have Kids Worship at 9:30 AM & 11:00 AM. If you sign up for a Life Group which meets during these times, you can use these programs without signing up.

There are four other times which Emmanuel provides childcare (Birth – 5th grade) for Life Groups which meet on the church campus *with the exception of Session 3 on Thursday morning which is for Birth thru Preschool (Age 5).

- Session 1 is Tuesday night 6:30 to 8:00 PM
- Session 2 is Wednesday night 6:30 to 8:00 PM
- *Session 3 is Thursday morning 9:30 to 11:30 AM
- Session 4 is Thursday night 6:30 to 8:00 PM

In order to use any of these sessions, you must email Karla Aguirre, kaguirre@myemmanuel.net by the deadline, <u>Sunday</u>, <u>August 81</u>, <u>2024</u>. Please see page #19 for detailed instructions for what to include in your email to Karla when registering your child for life group childcare.

For the safety of your children, we maintain a certain ratio of workers to children & we staff these sessions based on the number of children signed up. If you fail to sign up for childcare, you may be turned away.

Some Life Groups which meet at other times and places handle childcare in a variety of ways. Some leave it up to the individual parents to arrange for childcare, some pool together and hire a babysitter, and some swap babysitting services with parents who attend a group on another night. When you sign up for a Life Group, the group leader will contact you and will discuss how that group handles childcare. 




