When Jesus Gets in Your Boat Luke 5:4-11

Jesus is going to teach Peter that <u>obedience</u> is better than <u>sacrifice</u>.

Three important lessons about obedience.

1. Obedience isn't always logical. VV. 4-7

You can't always reason your way from <u>A</u> to <u>B</u>.

2. Obedience <u>affects</u> us and <u>those</u> around us. VV. 8-11

In one act of obedience Peter experienced the <u>power of God</u>, and it <u>changed</u> his life forever.

Peter was the key for James' and John's obedience.

3. Obedience is always <u>rewarded</u>. VV. 6, 10

Peter got a lot of fish. V. 6

Often the reward is a <u>clear conscience</u>.

Peter got a larger <u>call</u>. V. 10
