- A. We are aliens and strangers. v. 11
 - Four Challenges, vv. 12-16
- 1. Our Personal Challenge, vv. 11, 16
 - A. Abstain from fleshly lusts. vv. 11, 16
 - They wage war against the soul.
 - · We are not free to do wrong.
 - We belong to God.
- 2. Our Public Challenge, v. 12
 - A. Keep our behavior excellent. v. 12
 - The world's ways should not be our ways.
 - Eventually, we will be vindicated.
- 3. Our Civic Challenge, vv. 13-15
 - A. Be good citizens. vv. 13-15
 - Submit to governing authorities.
 - No command to obey unbiblical laws.
 - Governing authorities are supposed to honor God.
- 4. Our Intellectual Challenge, v. 15
 - A. Silence error. v. 15
 - The real problem is wrong ideas.
 - We are engaged in a battle of truth and error.
 - Truth will win.

- B. Love the brotherhood.
- C. Fear God.
- D. Honor the king.
