Why is 1 John written:

Chapter 1 is written to help <u>Promote</u> joy in your life. Ch. 1:4

Chapter 2 is written to help Prevent sin in your life. Ch. 2:1

Chapter 3 is written to help <u>Purify</u> love in your life. Ch. 3:1-3

Chapter 4 is written to help Protect truth in your life. Ch. 4:1-6

Chapter 5 is written to help Provide assurance. Ch. 5:13

What are the Marks that should be seen in every believer?

First mark of the believer is Fellowship with God. Ch. 1:5-7

Second mark of the believer is <u>Obedience</u> to His Word. Ch. 2:3-6

Third mark of the believer is <u>Love</u> for others. Ch. 3:11-19

Fourth mark of the believer is understanding <u>Truth</u> amongst Error. Ch. 4:1-6

Fifth mark of the believer is the <u>Witness</u> within himself. Ch. 5:9-13

The marks of the believer are not present so that we can become a Christian, but rather shows that we are a Christian.

These marks should be in the life of every believer to assure themselves that they are a child of God, and to show an unbelieving world the love and forgiveness of God.
